In terms of collaboration with NACE or other NGO some of the participants already will contribute to the session of TEG 453X at NACE 2013. IEAGHG R&D has expressed the interest to collaborate and to be a multiplier of the findings achieved within the research presented here and their projects.

The participants agreed to inform the partners within their projects about the existence of this exchange platform and the possibility of transferring it to an EFC Working Party.

There will be a workshop on the topic at EUROCORR 2013 in Estoril, Portugal. The next business meeting will be held after the workshop.
