

Best oral presentation awards

Two **oral presentation prizes**, recognizing outstanding communication skills of early career corrosionists, will be awarded during **Eurocorr2023** (Brussels 27-31.08).

About the awards

- We will reward the 2 most innovative presentations in terms of their communicative power and scientific quality. The goal of these presentation awards is to highlight outstanding skills to communicate scientific content, using them to enthuse, inspire and explain the subject and results.
- The awards are donated by the Materials Institute of UMONS (Belgium). A maximum of 2 awards are attributed during Eurocorr2023: 1 for a fundamental corrosion study and 1 for a more applied study.
- The value of each award is 1000 €. Payments are made after Eurocorr2023.

Eligibility

- Applicants must have less than eight-year professional experience upon submission (incl. PhD). Other applicants may also be considered if there are extraordinary grounds (e.g. illness, parental leave or similar circumstances) for doing so.
- Applicants must be first authors of an oral presentation at Eurocorr2023
- Applicants must register and attend Eurocorr2023

- Preselection of max. 10 finalists by a jury of Young EFC and local organizing committee members
- Selection of the awardees during Eurocorr2023
- Evaluation will be made by an independent jury panel based on communication skills (intuitive structure, grasping presentation, attractive graphical elements, clarity and conciseness, innovative use of technologies) and scientific aspects (scientific quality, potential impacts of the results, innovativeness of the approach).
